JACKSON COUNTY SCHOOLS APPLICATION

The TD Automotive Compressor Georgia (TACG) Scholarship was established at the North Georgia Community Foundation in 2006 to provide competitive scholarships to graduating seniors of public high schools in Jackson County, GA.

One **\$2,000** renewable award will be granted this year and will be renewable for three (3) successive years thereafter provided the recipient has demonstrated his or her ability to successfully and timely attain the college education being sought and funding is available. Applicants must be residents of Jackson County, Georgia and be graduating seniors of any public high school located there. Applicants must have a minimum 2.5 GPA and be pursuing an undergraduate degree full-time at an accredited U.S. institution in the fall. Up to five semi-finalists will be invited to a personal interview with the selection committee. One finalist will then be chosen.
